

## EAAE PROJECT SUPPORT POLICY

### EAAE CRITERIA TO ENGAGE IN R&D PROJECTS

1. The R&D project is on a European level, e. g. in the Horizon or Creative Europe programmes, or on transnational level.
2. The topic and methodology promise to advance research and innovation in architecture at a European level.
3. The project promises impact on frameworks for research and on policies at European and transnational levels.
4. The project complies with the mission, the values and the EAAE statute as well as with the EAAE Charter on Architectural Research.
5. Within a consortium the school asking should be full or associate member.

### PROCESS FOR SUPPORT

In order to be supported in R&D applications by EAAE (letter of support):

1. These requests for support should be presented 1 month before the deadline for submission.
2. The Council Members responsible for the Project Support Group review the request, assess its merits, and prepare an advisory recommendation for the Council.
3. The Council votes on the request in the next Council Meeting.
4. The Secretariat communicates the result of the vote to the party that submitted the request and arrangements are made for dissemination or other actions.

### PROCESS FOR PARTNERSHIP

EAAE may become a partner in R&D applications. In this case, EAAE's role should be to act as network, disseminator, policy advisor, resonator, organizer of and/or participator in transnational meetings and multiplier events.

To become a partner, EAAE should be contacted by the consortium team leader 3 months prior to the project submission.

## EAAE REPRESENTATIVE

The EAAE representative in the project needs to be a member of the Council, the Education Academy, the Research Academy, or of the Conservation Network. Her/his appointment is to be approved by the Council.

## QUESTIONNAIRE FOR APPLICATION

1. Please briefly present the project and the consortium (e.g. the programme, topic and scope of work, and the composition and background of the consortium).
2. What are the objectives, approach and methodology, novelty, and the envisaged impact?
3. Is the impact envisaged on research frameworks and on policies at European and national levels?
4. Illustrate how the project complies with the mission, the values and and the statute of EAAE as well as with the EAAE Charter on Architectural Research.
5. What is the expected contribution of EAAE and the foreseeable resources in the project?
6. Has the organisation participated in a European Union granted project before this application?
